## Donation Committee Report (Ed, Helen, Liesma)

One of *Imanta's* most important functions is the distribution of casino funds to a large number of beneficiaries in accordance with its business plan and *Alberta Gaming and Liquor Control (AGLC)* rules. The following is a summary of guidelines and recommendations that have been made by *Imanta's* donations committee:

- In order to maintain our status with AGLC and to continue to qualify as a casino beneficiary, we must maintain a certain level of membership in our society. Over the years our level of membership has steadily declined. We encourage all people of Latvian heritage in Edmonton, the Province of Alberta and elsewhere to become a member of *Imanta*. Moving forward, we will require that individuals using their Latvian connection to request donations be members of *Imanta*. We receive numerous requests from groups representing 'society at large' and will consider those separately.
- We are receiving an increasing number of donation requests and this is becoming a competitive process. We recommend that applicants broaden the scope of their donation requests, including: a description and background information of the organization; information about how the funds are to be used, a summary of the project budget and other efforts by the organization to raise funds; how the organization will benefit from the donation. It is always welcome when organizations report back as to the success of the project or initiative.
- A request approved in a prior year does not guarantee a subsequent approval.
- Donations should benefit as large and diverse a group of people as possible.
- Donation requests are considered semi-annually by May 1<sup>st</sup> and November 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.

We appreciate those individuals who volunteer to operate our casinos and encourage more people to help out at casinos and our other events – Family Day Picnic, Ligo Celebration, 18th of November and other events.
